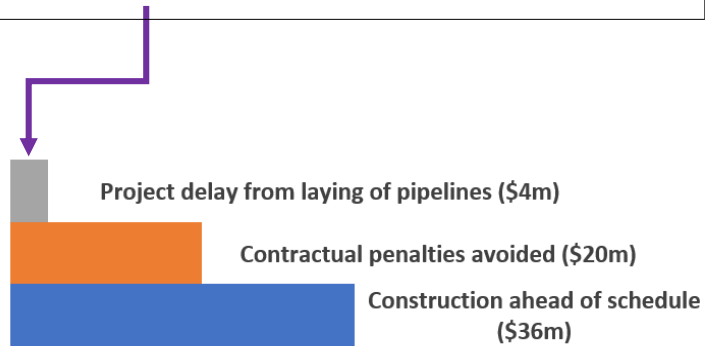

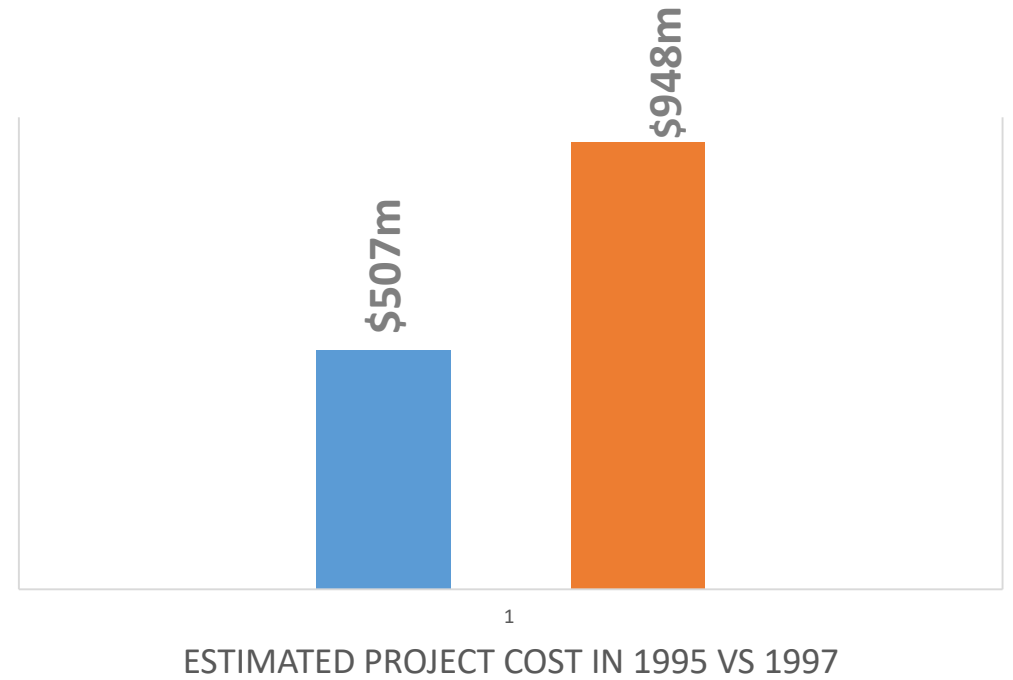

THE COST OF CONFLICT



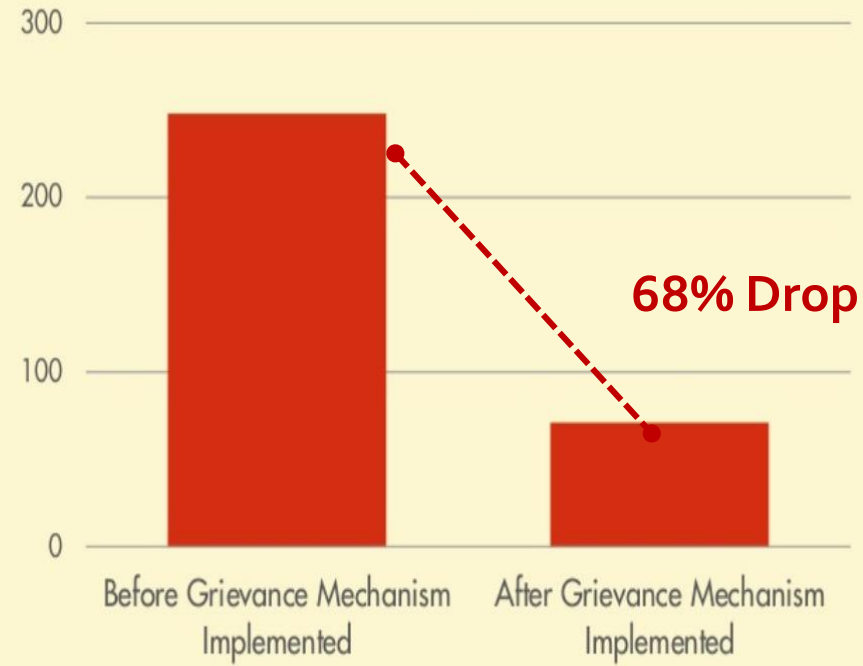
87% INCREASE IN COST DUE TO DELAY

LESSONS - ROYAL DUTCH SHELL

Protecting Value - Days lost to community protest



In one Shell operation, community protests were causing significant disruption to drilling. The introduction of a grievance mechanism enabled concerns to be captured proactively, sharply reducing delays.
